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Endnotes

1. Population figures also include First Nations Reserve populations for Abbotsford Mun, Chilliwack Mun, Coquitlam Mun, Delta Mun, Langley Township, North Vancouver Prov, Port Coquitlam Mun, Maple Ridge Mun, Nanaimo Mun, Squamish Mun, West Vancouver Mun, and Vancouver Mun.
2. Under the Police Act and the RCMP police agreements, a municipality becomes responsible for providing police services when it exceeds 5,000 population. Based on 2006 Census data published by BC Statistics, the District of Kent exceeded 5,000 population. As a result, the municipality signed a Municipal Police Unit Agreement effective April 1, 2009; prior to that date, the District of Kent was policed as part of Agassiz Prov. As only a partial year of data is available for 2009, some of the year's data may be included in Agassiz Prov.
3. According to the 2011 Canada Census results released February 8, 2012, the Township of Spallumcheen went over 5,000 population and, as a result, the Township became responsible for providing policing within its municipal boundaries effective April 1, 2012. Spallumcheen signed a Municipal Police Unit Agreement with the provincial government for the provision of RCMP municipal services. Prior to 2012, Spallumcheen Mun was policed by Armstrong Prov.
4. In 2009, crime data for Bella Bella Prov during the months of January to May are estimates.
5. Boundary/Grand Forks Prov, Boundary/Midway Prov, Castlegar Prov, Kaslo Prov, Naksup Prov, Nelson Prov, Salmo Prov, Slocan Prov and Trail and Greater District Prov are policed as a regional integrated detachment.
6. In 2005, crime data for Colwood Mun, Langford Mun, Outer Gulf Islands Prov, Sooke Mun and Sooke Prov, Sunshine Coast Prov, View Royal Mun, West Shore Prov during the months of March to October and North Saanich Mun, Sidney Mun and Sidney Prov for the months April to August are estimates due to the implementation of a new records management system.
7. According to the 2011 Canada Census results released February 8, 2012, the Town of Creston went over 5,000 population and, as a result, the Town became responsible for providing policing within its municipal boundaries effective April 1, 2012. Creston signed a Municipal Police Unit Agreement with the provincial government for the provision of RCMP municipal services. Previous to 2012, the Town of Creston was included in the area policed by Creston Prov.
8. Elk Valley is an integrated detachment which includes three provincial policing jurisdictions: Elkford Prov, Fernie Prov and Sparwood Prov.
9. In 2014, Houston Prov and Granisle Prov were formally amalgamated. Prior to this amalgamation, Houston/Granisle operated in an informally amalgamated manner from two Detachment offices; the main office in the District of Houston and the second in the Village of Granisle. The Granisle office remains and functions as a Community Policing Office.
10. The District of West Kelowna incorporated in 2007 with a population exceeding 15,000. The District of West Kelowna signed a Municipal Police Unit Agreement (MPUA) effective April 1, 2009; prior to that date, the District was policed as part of Kelowna Prov. Although the MPUA was effective April 1, 2009, reporting for 2009 for each of these policing jurisdictions covers the entire year.
11. According to the 2011 Canada Census results released February 8, 2012, the District of Peachland went over 5,000 population and, as a result, the District became responsible for providing policing within its municipal boundaries effective April 1, 2012. Peachland signed a Municipal Police Unit Agreement with the provincial government for the provision of RCMP municipal services. Previous to 2012, Peachland was included in the area policed by Kelowna Prov.

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12. The integrated Ridge Meadows RCMP Detachment is comprised of the following: the City of Maple Ridge; the City Pitt Meadows Municipal; and, Ridge Meadows Provincial policing jurisdiction. Due to data reporting inconsistencies between these jurisdictions undetermined at the time of publication, the number of crime incidents and crime rate should be used with caution as they may not be a meaningful indicator for these policing jurisdictions.
13. Within the municipalities of North Vancouver City and North Vancouver District there are a total of three First Nations reserve lands included within their municipal boundaries. The designated land title names for these reserve lands are: Mission 1 (North Vancouver City); and, Seymour Creek 2 and Burrard Inlet 3 (North Vancouver District). Due to inconsistencies in scoring crime data to the appropriate jurisdictions, in 2006 the populations for these reserve lands were assigned, along with the crime data, to North Vancouver Prov. Prior to 2006, populations for these areas were assigned to North Vancouver District. The crime rate should be used with caution because it may not be a meaningful indicator for this policing jurisdiction (due to the small residential population in the parks, and the relatively large amount of crimes occurring).
14. Provincial parks are located within the policing jurisdictions of North Vancouver Prov and Ridge Meadows Prov. Crime rates have not been included for these jurisdictions because they are not a meaningful indicator due to the small residential population and the relatively large amount of crimes occurring within the Provincial Parks.
15. Since the incorporation of Northern Rockies Mun in 2009, until they signed a Municipal Police Unit Agreement effective April 1, 2010, Northern Rockies Mun continued to be policed by the provincial force. From April 1, 2010 to March 31, 2012 the municipality was policed by Northern Rockies Mun with the remaining area policed by Northern Rockies Prov. Due to data inconsistencies, for the years 2010 to 2012 data for Northern Rockies Mun was included in data for Northern Rockies Prov. More recently, according to the 2011 Canada Census results released February 8, 2012, Northern Rockies Mun went under 5,000 population and, as a result, returned to being a provincial responsibility as of April 1, 2012 (the municipality was no longer responsible for providing police services within its municipal boundaries). A subsequent investigation by Statistics Canada showed that the jurisdiction was over 5,000 and, as a result, responsible for their own policing; Northern Rockies Mun signed a Municipal Police Unit Agreement with the provincial government for the provision of RCMP Municipal services effective of April 1, 2013. In this report, for the years 2013 and onwards, Northern Rockies Mun is showing its own data.
16. As of October 2010, Prince Rupert Provincial Unit took over policing of the Kitsoo/Klemtu area. The crime data has been revised for all year to reflect this change.
17. South Okanagan/Oliver Prov and South Okanagan/Osoyoos Prov are policed as an integrated detachment.
18. Stl'atl'imx Tribal Police Service is an autonomous and independent police service.
19. Sunshine Coast Prov includes the area policed as Gibsons Landing Prov.
20. Statistics for Surrey Prov are included in Surrey Mun. Also between April 1 and September 30 2014, the British Columbia Integrated Child Exploitation Unit (BC ICE) undertook a proactive project to record Internet Protocol (IP) addresses in possession of, and possibly sharing child pornography. This resulted in an increase in reported child pornography violations that year and all incidents detected by the by BC ICE unit were recorded in the records management system used by Surrey Police Service. Therefore, while the incidents were reported through Surrey and appear in crime statistics for Surrey (and the Vancouver census metropolitan area [CMA] as Surrey is within this CMA's boundaries), neither the incidents themselves nor the offenders are limited to Surrey. This will affect the figures seen for Total *Criminal Code* Offences, Crime Rate Total *Criminal Code* Offences and Total Other *Criminal Code* Offences.
21. Trail and Greater District is an integrated detachment which includes two provincial policing jurisdictions: Fruitvale Prov and Rossland Prov.
22. The Victoria Police Department polices the City of Victoria and the Town of Esquimalt.
23. The B.C. total includes additional reporting from the following specialized units: Canadian National Railway Police, Canadian Pacific Railway Police, RCMP Offshore/West Coast Marine Police, and South Coast BC Transit Authority Police.

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Definitions and Data Qualifiers

1. **Population figures** are estimates prepared annually by BC Stats, based on the results of the Canada Census which is conducted every five years. **Note:** In the 2011 Census, Statistics Canada adjusted the census boundary geographies and, as a result, the population estimates provided by BC Stats have been retroactively adjusted to reflect the updated census boundaries according to current police jurisdiction boundaries. Ten year population estimates included in this document may significantly differ from estimates included in the Police Services publications from prior years.

Population figures reflect only the permanent or resident population of a jurisdiction. Where a jurisdiction serves as a business and/or entertainment centre, it may have substantial “part-time” and “resident non-resident” populations relative to its resident or “late night” population, i.e., tourists, cabin owners, commuters, students, and seasonal staff. These temporary populations, whose permanent residence is within another jurisdiction, are excluded from a jurisdiction’s population figures.

2. **Number of offences** represents only those crimes reported to, or discovered by the police which, upon preliminary investigation, have been deemed to have occurred or been attempted; these data do not represent nor imply a count of the number of charges laid, prosecutions conducted, informations sworn or convictions obtained. The crime data contained in these reports have been recorded by the police utilizing the Uniform Crime Reporting 2 (UCR2) Survey scoring rules and guidelines. If a single criminal incident contains a number of violations of the law, then only the most serious violation is recorded for UCR2 purposes.
3. **Total Criminal Code offences** (excluding traffic) includes property, violent and other crimes.
4. **Crime Rate** is the number of *Criminal Code* offences or crimes (excluding drugs and traffic) reported for every 1,000 persons. It is a better measure of trends in crime than the actual number of offences because it allows for **population** differences. Crime rate for the *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act* (CDSA) are calculated per 1,000 population basis. Since the number of homicides and attempted murders reported is small, rates are calculated on a per 100,000 population basis. Crime rates for *Criminal Code* traffic offences are also calculated per 100,000 population basis.

Municipal crime rates do not necessarily reflect the relative safety of one municipality over another. More often than not, a high crime rate indicates that a municipality is a core city, i.e., a business and/or entertainment centre for many people who reside outside, as well as inside, the municipality. As a result, core cities may have large part-time or temporary populations which are excluded from both their population bases, and their crime rate calculations.

5. **Violent crimes** include the offences of homicide, attempted murder, sexual and non-sexual assault, sexual offences against children, abduction, forcible confinement or kidnapping, firearms, robbery, criminal harassment, extortion, uttering threats, and threatening or harassing phone calls and other violent offences.
6. **Property crimes** include the offences of breaking and entering, theft, motor vehicle theft, possession of stolen property, trafficking in stolen goods, fraud, mischief, identity theft, identity fraud, arson and altering/removing/destroying a vehicle identification number.

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7. **Other Crimes** include *Criminal Code* offences not classified as either violent or property crimes, e.g. prostitution, gaming and betting, offensive weapons, offences related to currency, offences against the administration of justice, offences against public order, etc.
 - Between April 1 and September 30 2014, the British Columbia Integrated Child Exploitation Unit (BC ICE) undertook a proactive project to record Internet Protocol (IP) addresses in possession of, and possibly sharing child pornography. This resulted in an increase in reported child pornography violations that year and all incidents detected by the BC ICE unit were recorded in the records management system used by Surrey Police Service. Therefore, while the incidents were reported through Surrey and appear in crime statistics for Surrey (and the Vancouver census metropolitan area [CMA] as Surrey is within this CMA's boundaries), neither the incidents themselves nor the offenders are limited to Surrey. This will affect the figures seen for Total *Criminal Code* Offences, Crime Rate Total *Criminal Code* Offences and Total Other *Criminal Code* Offences.
8. **Homicide** data are extracted from the Homicide Survey database. As a result of ongoing investigations in Port Coquitlam, BC there were 5 homicides reported in the Vancouver CMA total for 2007, 5 reported in 2004, 7 reported in 2003 and 15 included in 2002 that occurred in previous years. Homicides are counted according to the year in which police file the report.
9. **Motor Vehicle Theft** includes motor vehicle theft automobile, motor vehicle theft truck, motor vehicle theft motorcycle, motor vehicle theft other (e.g. snowmobiles, all terrain vehicles, motorized farming and industrial vehicles). In 2011, a new UCR violation code for motor vehicle theft was created, replacing the current UCR violations of motor vehicle theft over \$5000 and motor vehicle theft \$5000 and under.
10. **Administration of Justice** includes the following offences: fail to comply with order, escape or helps to escape from lawful custody, prisoner unlawfully at large, fail to appear, breach of probation, other violations against the administration of law and justice.
11. **Drug Offences** are crimes committed under the *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act* (CDSA). Drug offences include possession, trafficking, production, and distribution of cannabis, cocaine, heroin and other drug offences. These are not included in the Total *Criminal Code* offences.
12. Due to the differences in the organizational structure of each type of force, comparisons between independent municipal police departments and RCMP forces should be made with caution. For example, the RCMP municipal forces may have a relatively lower authorized strength because of the administrative support provided by "E" Division Headquarters.
13. Crime data from the previous years are revised to reflect any updates or changes that have been received from the police services. Therefore, crime statistics may vary slightly from year to year publications.
14. Generally, year-over-year comparisons should be made with caution as many non-criminally-related factors can affect data from one year to another (openings, closures or reorganizations of police departments, redistribution of municipalities serviced among different police departments, significant population increases, etc).
15. The data contained in this report may vary when compared with previous reports produced by Police Services Division. Where variances occur, the report produced at the latest date will reflect the most current data available.
16. The policing jurisdictions utilized in this report reflect operational policing in BC and may vary from those provided by Statistics Canada.
17. The population estimates reported in this document and used to calculate crime rates, are provided by BC Statistics and may vary from that provided by Statistics Canada.
